### The Husqvarna 572XP and 565AT: Better chainsaws in so many ways



**Husqvarna - one of the world's leading producers of forest, park and garden products - unveils the 572XP and 565AT chainsaws. Featuring an outstanding power-to-weight ratio and cutting performance respectively, these new saws are a force to be reckoned with for New Zealand landowners, farmers and professionals alike.**

The 572XP is a game-changer for New Zealand forestry professionals and the chainsaw industry itself, coming out to rave reviews. With a better power-to-weight ratio than any other Husqvarna saw with similar displacement and a 12 percent higher cutting capacity than previous models in the same cc-range, the 572XP is surpassing other models in the industry by more than 10 percent.

New Zealand arborist Scott Forrest was pleasantly surprised when he tested the saw.

The ergonomic design, balance and instant responsiveness along with the very impressive power to weight ratio assist me if I’m working aloft or on the ground by increasing my productivity.”

Other features include a heavy-duty filtration system allowing for long running intervals before cleaning – optimised for extended usage, day in, day out plus a rubber handle inlay for a trustworthy, comfortable grip.

The 565AT on the other hand is suitable for Kiwi landowners and farmers after a quick, safe, superior cut even with long guide bars. Featuring X-Torq® engine technology, this saw reduces harmful exhaust emissions by up to 75 percent and increases fuel efficiency by up to 20 percent giving you more bang for your buck. It also has a good power to weight ratio and air filtration, making it a perfect tool for high productivity during long days out in the paddock or bush. It even has a fuel purge to make it easier to start!

Both saws boast other features such as a 60 percent wider usable RPM range for peak performance under heavy loads. This makes for easier cutting due to a more forgiving motor character. Both saws are better suited for work with long guide bars.

They both also have a 20 percent higher cooling capacity plus a soft cut out system which means a longer engine life, easier restarts and will protect the motor from overrevving.

Add 10 times faster AutoTune™ into the mix and you’ve got two chainsaws ideal for New Zealand conditions. The new processor in both saws delivers instant engine tuning for best performance

and it automatically compensates for different fuels, altitudes, humidity, temperature and dirt in the air filter.
